Safety Guidelines

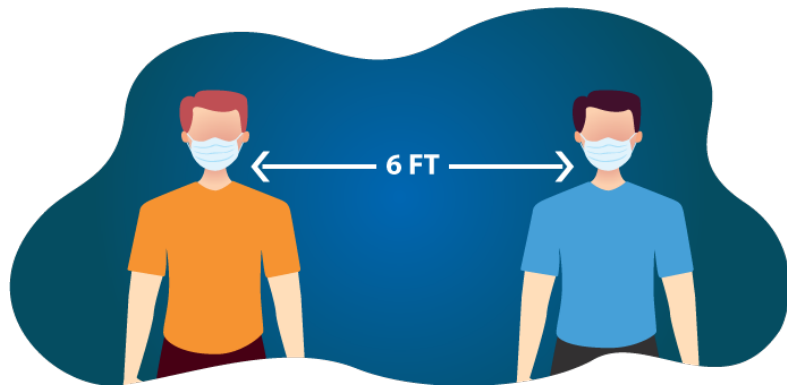
- Students and families will be required to wear masks during morning drop-off in the parking lot when out of their vehicles.
- Students are encouraged to wear their masks, but may remove their masks once they have entered their classroom or not in a crowded space.



- Everyone entering the gate must be temperature checked and use the hand sanitizer station before entry.
 - Teachers will wear masks throughout the school day and for all close contact teaching.
 - All staff will be temperature checked upon arrival and will follow all hand sanitizer/hand washing protocols.
 - Staff, students, and guardians with a temperature of 100.3 or above will not be permitted on campus.
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- Students will wash hands or use hand sanitizer upon entering and leaving classrooms and before all meal breaks.
 - Students in 7 through 12 will be required to use their own iPad/device to minimize contact with other student devices

Social Distancing Guidelines

- Students will be spread out during pickup to minimize interaction.
- Parents who choose to park and pickup students at the end of the school day must remain in their vehicles and wait for students to come out.



- The office will be open normal hours for your convenience. Parents entering the office must wear a mask, use sanitizer, and practice social distancing. Phone calls and emails are preferred to office drop-ins.
- The Pacheco campus is providing small class sizes for all grades and sizes are determined by the sizes of classrooms.
- Social distancing is being implemented. Student seating has been spread out throughout classrooms and the teacher's desk and the board are intentionally spaced from student work stations, but it is not possible for us to create 6 feet of space between all students within the classrooms.
- Student seating will be spread out for those choosing to eat in the CAFE and will face the same direction at lunch tables to avoid face to face contamination during break and lunch. Students may also

choose to eat outdoors in designated areas.

- Lockers will be assigned in a manner to minimize close interaction and students will not be allowed to congregate in locker area.
- Students will be encouraged to keep distance with friends and not to share objects.
- Volunteers will be limited and be permitted on campus only after screening. All volunteers must be temperature checked and use hand sanitizer in the office upon arrival. Volunteers must also wear masks at all times.
- High School students will use the locker rooms as the restroom and Junior High students will use the restrooms attached to the office building to minimize the number of persons using the space.
- Restrooms will be limited to two students at a time and must wash hands after use and sanitize hands upon entering the classroom.
- Students will enter the CAFE through the door by the chapel and exit through the door facing lockers to minimize close contact.
- Students must line up using social distancing while awaiting their turn to purchase lunch or snack items - students are encouraged to bring lunches and snacks from home.
- When transitioning between classes, students are encouraged to wear masks and entrance/exit of classrooms will be regulated to ensure reduction in cross-traffic

Additional Cleaning Procedures

- All high touch surfaces such as outdoor tables, doorknobs, gate push-bars, and bathroom surfaces will be disinfected multiple times daily, especially between breaks and lunch sessions.
- We are working towards installing CDC approved HEPA filters in every classroom for additional air filtration and will leave doors open whenever practical and possible.
- Touch-less sanitizer stations will be installed on campus and every classroom is equipped with Lysol wipes and hand sanitizer
- Additional cleaning procedures have been put in place to disinfect all computers and PE equipment between every use.
- All classrooms, bathrooms, and office spaces will be properly cleaned and disinfected daily.

- UV light treatments will be used each evening in all classrooms and office space when students are not present.
